6. Update on Proposal to Council regarding concrete blocks by arches - Guest: Ryan Cook

Ryan Cook, Manager of Public Works provided the committee with an update from council regarding the concrete blocks. Town staff was able to put together a report and presented it to council at the Oct 2nd meeting. Council voted to go with a slightly different vision. Instead of a stone veneer finish, Council's recommendation is an epoxy coating and polish on all the 8 concrete blocks. This will not impact if art is to be added later. The Sponsors recognition signage will be put into paving stones and added to the paving stones along Pelham town square and under the arches. This project will commence approximately early spring 2025.
